His parents do not own a house yet and are currently living with Anang's grandmother in a 54m2 house. Anang's father works in construction and sometimes drives a motorcycle taxi using a neighbour's motorcycle. His mother is a homemaker. Both his parents have only finished Elementary school.

Anang loves playing badminton, and practices regularly either at school or in the village centre. He also loves playing soccer and hopes that one day, he will become a successful person.

FAISAL

Faisal was born on February 25th, 1998. This school year, he will be entering High School (Grade 10) in SMA Cokro which is located very close to his home.

Faisal lives in Ciwalen village with his mother and 2 older siblings. His father passed away when Faisal was still a toddler. They live with Faisal's grandmother in a 45m2 house. Faisal's mother works as a housekeeper and earns Rp. 200,000 (AUS \$20) per month. Oftentimes, Faisal's aunt helps with the monthly expenses as she is a worker in a garment factory.

Faisal's two older sisters have only graduated from Middle School and his mother from Elementary School, so he will be the first person in his family to go to High School. Currently, one of his sisters is suffering from paralysis.

Faisal loves to play soccer and hopes that one day he can become a famous soccer player.

Muhammad was born on January 13th, 2001. This school year, he will be entering Grade 7 in SMPN 1 Sukaresmi, which is approximately 7km from his home.

Muhammad lives in Ciwalen village with both his parents in a house owned by them. The house is 80m2, but is in very clean condition. Muhammad's father no longer works since he's had a stroke, and his mother does not have a steady income from the small stall that she has at home. The family comprises of both parents and 5 children. Muhammad is the youngest, and 2 of his brothers and sisters are already married.

Muhammad always tries his best to do well in school. His grades are good and has already been in the top 10 of his class. His favourite subject is Science, but he is not very fond of Mathematics. His hobbies include playing basketball, which he loves, and when he grows older, he would like to be part of the Indonesian Army.

Besides playing basketball, after school Muhammad also helps his mother out at the small stall at home.

Nurus' hobbies include reading books, and she likes to help her parents when she comes back from school. She does not have a specific dream job, but she hopes that she will be successful in whatever job she will choose.
