To monitor the children's health and family conditions, YUM's staff regularly come to the children's houses. This visit gives the staff the opportunity to sit down and communicate with the parents and other family members, getting to know them better.



SCHOOL VISITS

Our beneficiaries study in different schools, so in order to know more about their academic progress, YUM's staff goes to each of their schools and communicate with their teachers.



MEDICAL CHECK-UP

Every year, all of our sponsored children receive free medical check ups twice a year (in December 2017 and June 2018). Thankfully all their results were good and none of them have problems with their health condition. YUM collaborated with the Cimacan community health centers' staff to check all of YUM's sponsored children.



RECREATIONAL ACTIVITES

On December 19th, 2017 all of the sponsored children went to see a waterfall in Taman Nasional Cibodas. They were very happy to be part of this activity.

Soon, on August 31st 2018, they will be going to a Jamboree camp in Mandala Kitri at Taman Nasional Cibodas. This activity is the first event for them where they will do a camping trip. They will also be doing outbound activities.



WORKSHOP FOR TEENAGERS

Pak Yudi, a community health staff, and ibu Tarkiyah, YUM's staff, provided health information for teenager to all our sponsored children. The children were very excited to attend this activity. It gave them the opportunity to receive knowledge and ask questions about teenage issues that they would otherwise not receive elsewhere.



BI-MONTHLY GATHERINGS WITH THE STUDENTS AND THEIR FAMILY

Every two months, all the parents have to come to YUM's center to attend education workshops. Ibu Tarkiyah always provides useful information to the parents, so they will be able to apply that information in their life such as health issues concerning children, parenting styles and nutrition.

YAYU YUGANA

Yayu graduated from Senior High school at SMA Cokroaminoto Cipanas and last month she celebrated her graduation (see photo below). Her performance at school was good, Last semester, she got an average score of 86.3 points for 14 subjects.

Yayu is a fortunate child, After graduating from school, she immediately got a job offer. She now works as a waitress at Thai tea in Mall Icon Walk Tangerang and she lives with her relatives in a rented room,





Yayu is the eldest child in the family, She has two siblings, Her father passed away a few months ago, so now her younger siblings only have their mother to support then, and she herself is struggling to support the family.

Yayu's mother works as a waiters in a Padang restaurant, Her income is very limited; she gets a daily income of IDR 35,000 (AUD 3.2).

FAISAL AMBARDI

Faisal has studied very well at school and he graduated from Senior High School a few months ago. Last semester his average score was 79.8 points for all 14 subjects. Faisal is a sporty child, His hobby is playing football and once a week he always plays football with his friends.

Faisal comes from a modest family, He lives with his mother and older sister, while his father passed away a few years ago. In order to support the family, his mother works as domestic labor with a monthly income of IDR 300,000 (AUD 30),

After graduate from school, Faisal works as an administration staff at Villa Intan Cipanas, Faisal is very much enjoying to be a worker because he will get an income every month and is able to support his family.



M.RIDWAN

Ridwan graduated from Junior High School and last semester his average score was 78.3 points. Unfortunately, he has decided to not continue his studies to Senior High School because his parents do not have enough money to support the studies of all their children. Entering High School in Cipanas requires more financial commitment and even though Ridwan's family received help from Glo-Wing, there preferred to focus on getting the younger children to stay in school. For this reason, Ridwan has decided to work selling plastic bags in the Cipanas market.

Ridwan comes from a modest family. He lives with his family in a rented house and every month his father has to pay IDR 350,000 (AUD 35) for the rent of the house. In order to support the family, his father works as a labor however he does not have a fixed income, while his mother is only taking care of the family.

USI SAFITRI

Usi has a good motivation to learning everything. She is now in the second (2nd) grade of Senior High School at SMA Tauhidul Afkar. Last month she already received her report card and the scores were good. Her average score was 81.7 for all 15 subjects.

After school she joins two kinds of extracurricular activities: Girl's Scout on Thursdays and Martial Art (Karate) on Fridays. Usi's hobby is reading. She often comes to YUM's library to read and borrow a book (see photo).

Usi is the eldest child in the family, she has one younger sister and the family lives in their grandmother's house. Usi's father works as a construction labor, receiving a daily income of IDR70,000 (AUD 7).





HIKMAH RAMDANI

Hikmah is doing very well in school; she was ranked 5th in her class with an average score of 85 points. Hikmah is now in the second (2nd) grade of Senior High School at SMA Cokroaminoto Cipanas.

Hikmah is a cheerful child. At school she is part of the flag bearing team and in YUM she joins the angklung class on a weekly basis,

Hikmah and her sibling live with their grandmother, while her mother lives separately in Cianjur so Hikmah rarely meets her. Hikmah's mother works as a domestic labor with a monthly income of Rp. 800,000 (AUD 80) while her grandmother works as a farm labor with no fixed income.






M. ISWANDI

Iswandi is doing very well in school. He graduated from Junior High School with good results. His average score was 88.2 points. Iswandi is now in the first (1st) grade of Vocational High School at SMKN I Cipanas.

Iswandi very much enjoys studying in his new school, He has new friends and new experiences. At school he joined the Youth Red Cross as his extracurricular activity.

Iswandi and family live in their own house, in order to support the family, his parents work as a farm labors. Their income is very limited. His father's daily income is IDR 40,000 while his mother's daily income is IDR 20,000.



ADI RISMA

Adi is now in the first (1st) grade of Vocational High School at SMK Al - Ujlal, Pacet and he lives in a boarding school. He rarely meets with his parents, however he enjoys studying in his new school.

Twice a week he joins the Boy Scout and Youth Red Cross club as his extracurricular activities. Adi loves doing sports very much and his favorite sport is playing football.

Adi's father works as a construction labor. His income is not much, his daily income is IDR 60,000 while his mother is taking care of the family.





M. JAENAL

Jaenal has done very well at school. A few months ago he graduated from Junior High School with an average score of 84 for all 11 subjects. Right now he is in the first (1st) grade of Senior High School with social science as his major at SMAN I Sukaresmi.

Jaenal is an obedient child. After school he often helps his mother to do house work and in the evening he always studies and does his homework. In the future, he really wants to be a successful person so his mother can be happy and proud of him.

Jaenal's mother is the breadwinner because his father has already passed away. She is very much struggling to support the family. She has a small stall but she doesn't have a fixed income depending on how many customers buy her products that day.




IMAM AKBAR

For this reason, she has to manage her income very well to be able to cover all the expenses such as daily needs and her children's education needs.
